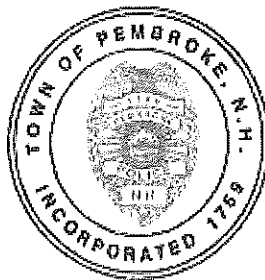

The State Fire Marshal's Office, in accordance with RSA – C:10(I) is in the process of updating its list of municipalities in the State of New Hampshire where the use, display or possession of permissible/consumer fireworks is restricted or prohibited. New Hampshire RSA 160 – C:6 states that:

*“Any municipality in the state, by action of its local legislative body or local governing body, may vote to allow or to prohibit, within that municipality, the issuance of permits or licenses to sell permissible fireworks or the display or possession of permissible fireworks.”*

**Please Note:** This list denotes specific community restrictions enacted, per NH RSA 160-C:6 "Local Option", to further restrict the use of Permissible Fireworks beyond the requirements of NH RSA 160-C. Consult local town ordinances for further information.

**DEFINITIONS**

**"Permissible – No local restrictions":** The local community has no adopted ordinance for the possession and/or display of Permissible Fireworks. NH RSA 160-C: 11 still apply.

**"Permissible – Permit required":** The consumer must obtain a local permit in addition to state law requirements – contact local fire department.

**"Permissible – Restrictions":** The local community allows the use of consumer fireworks, but certain restrictions beyond state law apply – contact the local fire, or police department for further information.

**"Prohibited":** The sale, possession, and display of Permissible Fireworks is prohibited.

**"Prohibited – Display only":** Only the public display of Permissible Fireworks is allowed through the local permitting process.

Dear Selectman Team,

I sent this same message out several months ago and never heard from any of you as to what you are going to do about my concerns. I strongly believe something should be done before a potential life threatening accident happens.

First and foremost, I would like you to know I am just trying to improve the town, not upset anyone. I want to be able to sit in my house and feel safe and enjoy the peacefulness of Pembroke.

I have contacted the Pembroke town manager who suggested I contact you folks in regards to my concern. I have also spoken with the State Fire and NH Safety Department a while back and their suggestion was to contact the town officials in regards to the fireworks.

**My concern is:** Fireworks being allowed in our town of Pembroke by the lay person(s). I have several neighbors and others close by who shoot them off most of the summer, and New Years. I find this a very irritating and disturbing nuisance for several reasons. First of all, I live on Rt 3 a

very busy road. Fireworks are going off over the road or darn close. This is a potential for an accident or a driver being surprised and losing control and hitting my house, or another vehicle or person. The noise factor, the time, the fact I am trying to enjoy a tv show, the fact that I have tenants that have to work, have PTSD, my husband has anxiety and I get stressed (which is not healthy for me), re this disrespect for others. This also places a fire danger to my house and yard as I get the debris in my yard, ashes on my tenants cars. I also feel that a stray firework could come through my house or yet a vehicle going by. I am not going to call the police every time. They have better things to do. Fireworks were not meant for the lay person. They are meant for the professionals and a one night affair in a safe environment for all who **want to** hear them. Please consider banning them from Pembroke and or work with the state to ban them. Obviously, if there is a rule, then violators, I will call on. The town of Pembroke does have a noise ordinance and why have it if the police have to be called every time. Simple solution is don't allow it.

**My other issue** is the sidewalk from Donna Drive North to 106. There is a lot of overgrowth along the wall. I have worked with Joe Bosivert and his team some last year. I understand they do their best. I also understand that the residents are responsible for maintaining their shrubs and "weeds" that encroach upon the walk way. There are plants that need to be cut way back off the wall, and ones over the wall. A section of grass (just past Bean Hill Rd, and the stretch in front of the big field just past Donna Drive) needs to be mowed down and back. As well as the bushes before the field. In my opinion there should be nothing hanging over into the sidewalk or growing into the sidewalk. Also, residents need to remove snow from around their mailboxes so people can stay on the sidewalk when walking. Plus not rake their leaves to the bottom of the driveways into the sidewalk. Rt 3 is a very busy road and most drivers are texting not paying attention so to have a sidewalk that is free from debris would be good. My husband and I have witnessed drivers coming into the breakdown lane because they are texting or looking down at their phones.

If the town took a good size mower (like the state) has and brush cut, it would not take them long at all. Get all the bushes and vines etc, cut 2 feet back from the edge, or from over hanging into the walk way. Just a suggestion.

**My last issue** is incessant dog barking throughout the day. One neighbor has 2 poodles who bark at thin air every time they go out. I have already spoken to them last summer late fall. again the noise ordinance rule. By the time I call the police the dogs are inside. I believe also dogs are to be leashed or fenced in and with an owner with them?? If this is correct then what can be done with this neighbors 2 dogs?, as well as other neighbor hood dogs coming into my yard to do their business. I want to be respectful but at the same time I would like to enjoy peace and quiet in my own yard and home, and not have to clean up others messes. My suggestion is a letter out to dog owners to inform them of leash laws and fenced in rules, and noise ordinance.

I would deeply appreciate anything your team can do to help keep Pembroke a quiet and nice place to reside.

I do not wish for the issues to inflate and become a bigger problem. I would like to see some follow through and resolution to the above concerns/issues. I would like to remain anonymous. I look forward to hearing from you with a solution.

Please limit the traffic count requests to ***five (5) priority locations and five (5) secondary locations*** per municipality. If there are specific data requests relating to the timing of the count or the types of data being collected please make note on the attached form.

CNHRPC has expanded the region's bicycle and pedestrian count data by offering to help member communities establish bicycle and pedestrian counting programs. If your community is interested in establishing bike/pedestrian counting stations, please contact Dean Williams to further discuss this opportunity.
