PEMBROKE FIRE DEPARTMENT

Recommendation for Purchase of New Fire Pumper

May 20, 2019

The Fire Department requested \$748,414 for the purchase of a new pumper truck and equipment in 2019. This request was approved through a warrant article at the 2019 Town Meeting.

General specifications were developed by the Chief, Assistant Chief and Deputy Chief of the Department. These specifications were submitted to three nationally known manufacturers of fire trucks with the request of them to submit to us specifications and plans for a vehicle that met our general specifications and needs. They were asked to submit their proposals by 3/29/2019.

We received plans and specifications in a timely manner from two of the manufacturers – Emergency One and Seagrave. The third manufacturer, Pierce, completed submitting plans to us on 5/7/2019.

After receiving the proposals, we created a comparative spread sheet of all three proposals that showed each item and area on the trucks as compared to each other. We also expanded the purchasing and decision-making group to include our two Captains. We then met with each manufacturer and discussed differences and alternatives on all items. This resulted in each making some adjustments in their proposals that put each of them closer to being identical in features and specifications of specific areas of the vehicle.

Our recommendation is to purchase the vehicle from Seagrave Fire Trucks in the amount of \$690,929. Their cab and body are made with stainless steel entirely and the type of construction and materials is identical to our Seagrave ladder tower. There are many more details of their vehicle that we view as far superior to the other proposals. Most importantly we believe the vehicle will meet our goal of a 30 year life span which results in the lowest annual acquisition cost of \$23,031.

Emergency One submitted a price of \$604,899. While it was similar to the Seagrave proposal they could only offer stainless steel construction for the body but not the cab. We also believe that it most likely will have a life span of 25 years rather than

the 30 years we are looking for and what our CIP plans is based on. Their annual acquisition cost is estimated to be \$24,196.

Based on very poor response to our requests for proposals and needs we are not considering the Pierce proposal at \$632,011. We also do not think it will meet our 30 year life cycle goal. The annual acquisition cost is estimated to be \$25,280.

We will have all planning documents with us when we meet. We will also give you additional information as to why we believe Seagrave is the best value for the Town.

- 2) Submit the form along with copies of the deeds, assessing cards, and any surveys you may have for the lots being merged to the Planning and Land Use Department at the Town Hall. The survey is not required but is helpful in the review process. The form will be signed at the next available Planning Board meeting.
- 3) A \$25 fee per lot plus a \$25.00 administrative fee must be paid to the **Town of Pembroke** at the time of submission to cover the costs of recording the merger, i.e. the fees required for a two-lot merger request will be \$75.00.
- 4) Once the request is approved and signed by the Planning Board, Planning Staff will record the original. The MCRD mails the original back to the Town, which is kept on file in our records.. We provide a copy of it to the owner and to the Assessing Department.
