Requests for trust fund reimbursements

The trust fund requests are as follows; transfer \$8,735.65 from the Town Building Fund for Sewer Line and Generator Repair, \$6,568.42 from the Police Small Equipment Fund for AED's, \$362,414.29 from the Fire Small Equipment Fund for Air Packs and a Compressor, \$9,225 from the Cemetery Improvement Fund for Pembroke Hill Paving, \$18,371.10 from the Recreation Fund for Dugouts/Soccer

Roof, \$407,541.50 from the Town Equipment Fund for a Chipper, 6-Wheel, and the Balance of a 10-Wheeler from 2022, \$69,631.19 from the Police Cruiser Fund for the balance of a cruiser from 2022 and a new cruiser, and \$18,173.76 from the Property Revaluation Fund for revaluation work for a total of \$990,660.91 to the General Fund.

Selectman Goulet made a motion to accept the trust fund reimbursements. Selectman Gagyi seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

VI. Town Administrator Report

NH House Bill 2 gave additional funds from the highway block grant. Pembroke will receive \$47,453.26 that will need to be formally accepted at the next meeting.

Mary Ann Ricciotti has submitted for retirement effective February 15, 2024 after 30 years of service. The Chief has requested a 2.5% merit increase based on her most recent review. Selectman Goulet made a motion to approve the 2.5% increase and for it to be a lump sum payment. Selectman Gagyi seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Selectman Goulet made a motion to approve a 2.5% merit increase for Adam Mendozza. Selectman Frederickson seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Selectman Goulet made a motion to approve a stipend for the Department of Public Works employees due to being down three employees who normally plow. The stipend will be paid in two installments, one this year and one in April after plowing season is done, Selectmen Frederickson seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Selectman Gagyi – Budget discussed the library budget. They are looking to increase the hours of the children's librarian and to also add a part time position to help with shortages in staffing. Gerry discussed the SAU budget and his concerns that he still has not received the most recent audited financial statements. Tomorrow night they will discuss Fire and Ambulance.

Selectman Frederickson – Planning met with Steven Whitley regarding some proposed zoning changes to define what a single-family home is. The sober living facility would not be effected by any future zoning changes. They also discussed warrant articles for the upcoming year.
