Cemetery Commission Six Year cemetery plan:

- 1. Pine Trees at entrance of Pembroke Hill Cemetery/Possible repaving the driveway and replacing culvert at entrance to Cemetery. Updating gate with new coat of paint
- 2. Removal of trees at New North Pembroke Cemetery
- 3. Widen the entrance (one or all three) to Evergreen cemetery by relocating granite sidewalls
- 4. Restore old gates at Pembroke Street
- 5. Update Cemetery mapping with Town wide Cemeteries surveyed with GPR
- 6. Gazebo in Evergreen Cemetery- to install new one like the one in the 1950's plan.
- 7. Find a Cemetery Design company for designing a Columbarium in the back area at Evergreen Cemetery
- 8. Wrought iron fence surrounding a family plot- potential hazard
