

MEET ME IN SUNCOOK!
Minutes of Meeting
May 4, 2010

Present: Noreen Bean, Joyce Belanger, Gerry Belanger, Jocelyn Carlucci, Norma Daviault, Ron Daviault, James Garvin, Doc Greco, Joyce McKay, Roger Menard, Larry Perron, Jan Shichkin, Joyce Welch. Also present was Claudette Verville, representing the Allenstown Historical Society.

1. Chair Jocelyn Carlucci called the meeting to order at the old Pembroke Fire and Police Station at 7:09 p.m.
2. On a motion by Jan Shichkin, seconded by Ron Daviault, the minutes of March 2, 2010, were unanimously approved.
3. Noreen Bean delivered the treasurer's report, as follows:

Meet Me in Suncook now has a new carrier for our liability insurance policy, and our former \$260 premium has been slightly reduced under the new carrier.

4. On a motion by Joyce McKay, seconded by Joyce Welch, the treasurer's report was unanimously approved as presented.
5. Jocelyn gave an update on the next newsletter, noting that Ingrid has kindly sent some copy. The available text may now have to be cut slightly. We still need photographs of Roger Menard on last year's Old Home Day float, of Roger as umpire, and of the 250th anniversary bus tours. We should also try to find a photograph of last year's art contest entries exhibited under the tent on Old Home Day.
6. Jim Garvin reviewed the status of the two proposed Robert Frost markers: the state historical marker, which is suggested for a site on Route 28 near the Buck Street Dam, and a simple granite marker, suggested for the small town-owned riverside park on Buck Street. He reported that the two texts for the state marker have been drafted, footnoted, and submitted to the colleague in his office who administers the marker program. Since a "cooperative" state marker costs \$1,750, the committee has chosen to wait until future re-funding for new state markers will pay the cost of this marker. Joyce Belanger noted that Bodie Morey of Emerson Mill Condominiums has a friend who might donate toward the cost of one or both markers. Joyce suggested that we try to find out whether this person might be interested in assisting with either marker.
7. Claudette Verville discussed the possibility of a float for Old Home Day, August 28th. The subject is "Under the Big Top." The Allenstown Historical Society is interested in cooperating with *Meet Me in Suncook*. We might be able to use Tom Hebert's truck, or Doc Greco's 22-foot trailer. Many suggestions were made for the circus theme, all involving Roger in some way. The

final idea (subject to change) was to construct a cage from PVC tubes and have a lion tamer in the cage, together with a variety of stuffed animals.

8. Jocelyn reported that she needs to tell the Old Home Day Committee whether anyone wants to serve as a greeter between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Ron and Norma Daviault and Noreen Bean expressed a willingness to serve.
9. Jim Garvin turned over the two freshly dry-cleaned Suncook Cornet Band tunics to Noreen Bean for placement in the vault. Noreen reported that she had visited Claudette's house and learned how to inventory historical collections and what supplies are needed. Regarding placement of items such as the Cornet Band uniforms in the town vault, we need to develop a method of hanging clothing in the vault properly.
10. The next meeting of *Meet Me in Suncook* will be on Tuesday, June 1, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the old Pembroke Fire and Police Station to discuss Old Home Day preparations and other items of business. The committee may choose not to hold a formal meeting in July if there is no need.
11. On a motion by Noreen Bean, seconded by Jim Garvin, the meeting adjourned at 8:08 p.m.
