

INVITATION TO BID 2010-2011 WINTER SAND

The Town of Pembroke, NH is seeking bids for **winter sand** to be delivered to and picked up by the Pembroke Public Works Department, 8 Exchange Street, Pembroke, NH. Approximately 4,000 tons of sand will be needed from November 1, 2010 to October 31, 2011.

All bids must provide a price per ton for sand delivered and sand picked up by the Town of Pembroke. All bids must be received by Thursday, August 19, 2010 at 2:00 p.m., in a sealed envelope marked "**Winter Sand Bid**", to: Pembroke Town Hall, 311 Pembroke Street, Pembroke, NH 03275. The Board of Selectmen reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids and to award the bid in the best interest of the Town of Pembroke.

Winter Sand Specifications Town of Pembroke, NH

The winter sand will meet the following gradation ranges:

Sieve Size	Percentage Passing
3/8	100
#4	80-100
#10	60-95
#20	30-85
#40	5-40
#100	<10
#200	<5

The successful bidder will submit gradation test results from an approved soils lab of their proposed winter sand supply.

The successful bidder will supply approximately 4,000 tons throughout the year, of the aforementioned material to the Pembroke Public Works Garage at 8 Exchange Street, Pembroke, NH.

If the successful bidder is unable to supply winter sand to the Town of Pembroke in the quality and quantity specified for any reason, said bidder will be responsible for any and all additional costs above the approved unit bid to supply the Town of Pembroke with winter sand from other sources.

Delivery of said material will be made within 48 hours of placing the order. However, if the Director of Public Works, or his designated representative, declares that an emergency condition exists, delivery will be made within 24 hours. In the event that

delivery cannot be made as specified, the Director of Public Works reserves the right to fill that order with any available source.

Successful bidder must submit a certificate of insurance, naming the Town of Pembroke as certificate holder, covering general liability, auto liability, and worker's compensation coverage.

The obligation incurred by the acceptance of this bid is limited to the Pembroke Public Works Department actual requirements, be it 4,000 tons or more or less.
