## MINUTES Tuesday, June 2, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:05 P.M.

### 1. Attendance:

Present: Jim Boisvert, Buddy Curley, Henry Malo, Paulette Malo, Oscar Plourde, Brian Seaworth, Planning Board Rep., Floyd Smith

### 2. New Business:

- a. **2009 Paving Bid Update:** Jim explained that the Board of Selectmen approved Suburban Paving for the road paving, CLD for the sidewalks, and Fiorentino Asphalt Maintenance for the crack sealing. He then explained that the Board of Selectmen approved items 2 through 9 of the 2009 Road Paving Schedule and they are waiting for the bids for North Pembroke Road to come in before they approve anything else.
- b. **Belanger Drive Update:** A discussion ensued about the School charging the developer for access to Belanger Drive. As of the last Planning Board meeting it was left that building the road straight through to Belanger Drive was a dead issue but the Committee still feels that building the road straight through to Belanger Drive is the best way to go.

### 3. Any New Business:

- a. **Silver Hill Development:** The Committee reviewed the plans proposing a temporary hammerhead. The Committee questioned how long the timeframe for “temporary” was. The Committee does not favor dead ends and had some concerns with the temporary easement for the turnaround. The Committee discussed how the Town has been having some issues with easements in other areas of Town and this being a “Temporary” easement. Some members of the Committee were concerned because they felt that tractor-trailers would have no room to turn around. The Committee would rather see a cul-de-sac than a temporary hammerhead. The committee agrees that should the hammerhead be installed that it should be paved and have delineator post installed.

**Motion:** Brian moved to recommend to the Planning Board that if there is no timeframe for the temporary hammerhead than the Committee recommends a cul-de-sac instead of a temporary hammerhead. Should the hammerhead be installed that it should be paved and have delineator post installed.

**4. Any Old Business:**

- a. Traffic Counts:** Brian brought in the 2009 traffic count requests for the Committee to review as prepared by Central NH Planning Commission. The Committee reviewed the traffic count requests and all agreed that it was correct.
- b. Sidewalk East of Wilkens Ave.:** The Board of Selectmen approved the removal of this sidewalk and Jim stated that it is on his to do list.
