3. Update: Landfill Closure and Recycling Facility - Phase 1

Jim Boisvert: the first bidder, Jennings, wanted to get out of the contract. The town will meet on November 21 with the next lowest bidder, RD Edmonds, which bid \$4 - 7,000 more than Jennings, and includes a safety survey.
