**OLD BUSINESS**

A. Reading of Minutes

LL Door - Rose will contact Tom Hebert to see if he is still willing to purchase and install a new door for the little league building.

C. LED Motion Lights

Lights have been installed in both bathrooms. Cost was \$684.80

D. Donation Punch List - Items that were discussed - fence bball area / regrade infields, soccer low spots, tennis court/bball court – crack repair, LL door, fence repairs, tree trimming along river,

E. Softball Infield - It was voted at the September meeting to grade softball infield after concerns were presented to the commission from the Co-Ed league. Rose contacted Kirk Weyant to laser grade. Mr. Weyant said it would be better to do in the spring. Rose will be in contact with him this spring to finish the project.

F. Trees Pruning - The money was encumbered as Jungle Jim could not get to the field last fall. Rose made a motion to use the ARC donation to have Jungle Jim clear along the river for better viewing of the regatta. This would be cost effective as we will have them on the property. Steve seconded. Motion passed.
