A. Reading of Minutes

Teams enjoyed using the field and were very respectful. He did mention that the infield could use some grading (second base, pitching mound, home plate, and a build up in back of third – probably from years of people sliding into the base. It has probably been over 10 years that it was last done.

Rose mentioned the major field needs some infield work also. Doc added that Rose ask Kirk to look at that field and see if we can make improvements to major field while the equipment is there. Doc made a motion to have the field graded by Mr. Weyant. Sharon seconded - All in favor.

C. CIP - update - Members agreed to look over long range plans to see if they should move items. We will review this in the spring of 1019.

D. Middle Field Dugout - Tom Hebert secured the middle field dugout that was leaning. He is checking pricing on metal roofs. Rose also asked Tom to also get a metal roof above the concession stand (shingles are coming off)

E. Village School - Town manager sent out email that the school board has made the decision to close the village school at the end of the academic year. This will impact our summer rec program as the school is close to the field and the program uses it in case of heavy rain/thunder. They have established a committee to aid in the closing. Sharon and Rose agree to volunteer on the committee. Sharon will contact the school board chair, Dan Driscoll, to let him know.

F. Cameras - Rose reported that the police were able to identify children that vandalized porta potty. Rose gave bill from United to police department.

G. Scouts - Rose reported that J. Lawrence (no smoking signs) earned his Eagle Scout Badge. Congratulations Jonathan!!!

R. Martineau contacted Rose as he is interested in repairing horseshoe pits for his Eagle Scout Project. He will get back to Rose if his project is accepted.
