3. Scheduled Meetings: None

- **4. Old Business: a. Any Old Business: Grinder at Rte. 106:** Paulette explained that AAA Pumps are in the process of the removal and replacement of this grinder (Muffin monster). The job should be completed by the end of this week.
- **b. Mission Systems:** Paulette explained that the remaining three stations are now equipped with the Mission system. These systems are the same as the one that was installed at Bow Lane during the upgrade. The phone lines will be disconnected at the three stations. Paulette will contact Pete Boettcher and let him know that the alarm systems have all been changed to the Mission system.
- **c. Camera Systems:** Paulette explained that the camera systems have all been installed at the remaining stations. There are 4 cameras at each location, one for each side of the buildings.
- **d. Bow Lane Station:** Paulette explained that the remainder of the punch list has been completed this past weekend. The last item that needs to be completed under the Bond is the Asset Management Program with Hoyle Tanner.
