**GENERAL LEGISLATION**  
**CHAPTER 51**

**[HISTORY: Adopted 3-8-1977 Town Meeting Article No. 14. Amendments noted where applicable.]**

**§ 51-1 Title.**

This bylaw shall be known as "an ordinance relative to prohibiting alcoholic beverages and obstructions to streets."

**§ 51-2 Open containers prohibited; penalty.**

It shall be unlawful to consume or carry an open container of any alcoholic beverage on any public way or public sidewalk within the Town of Pembroke. Persons violating this provision shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.).

**§ 51-3 Obstruction of traffic prohibited; penalty.**

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, without necessity, to place any object upon or to assemble on a public highway or sidewalk in a manner which interferes with the free passage and safety of pedestrian or vehicular traffic. Persons violating this provision shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.).
