Cemetery Commission Six Year cemetery plan:

- 3. Restore old gates at Pembroke Street Cemetery
- 4. Update Cemetery mapping with Town wide Cemeteries surveyed with GPR
- 5. Gazebo in Evergreen Cemetery- to install new one like the one in the 1950's plan.
