- 2. Planning Board Applications
- a. 464 Seventh Range Rd: Web Stout, Surveyor
 - a. Wetlands permit application, minimal impact, Mr. Berube upgraded seventh range road from class six road to class five road. Wants to subdivide 8 acres off the 42 acres. This project involves the filling of 1,050 sqft of forested wetlands for a proposed one lot subdivision for a single-family residence. The proposed lot is approximately 7.971 acres in size and the proposed crossing is to gain access over an existing woods trails to the building portion of the lot. The proposed location is at the narrowest and flattest part of the wetland with the least amount of impact. Two 12 inch/30 ft culverts.
 - b. Jenny motioned to approved application as presented. Wendy seconded. All in favor.
- b. Other: Dale Robinson property. Rokeh Consulting. Grading drainage and erosion control. Proposed land subdivision. Tax map 262 lot 45, 373 Fourth Range Rd. 52 single-family homes. Two wetland impact areas: 16,200 sqft. 8,000 sqft. 10 road way impacts: 33,577 sqft. 6 driveway impacts: 4,232 sqft. Septic and well water. 177 acres total in this subdivision, there would be .85 acres of direct wetland impact, 727 sqft. of wetland impact per dwelling. NHR had no hits. Town requirements for loop road has a huge impact. CC interested in discussing with Planning board how these new requirements are impacting proposed land subdivisions.
