

Energy Committee July, 11, 2019 Minutes

Need ideas from the committee for their request to CIP for August 14, 2019 CIP meeting.

Suggestions of having Solar Companies come in and give quotes of turning one or more town building over to solar for electricity. Request \$30,000 and outline what the Energy committee's Solar project.

Will have Solar companies call David to set up appointments to view the Town buildings, meters and where solar panels can be installed.

- a. Revision Company
- b. Granite State Solar
- c. Look at the Town assessment maps for possible location of solar panels.
- d. Pembroke Library roof will need to be replaced within 5 years (may be a good location for panels)
- e. See where the high demand is for each Town building
- f. Get copies of electric and gas rates for each building

Street lights update: Eversource completed phase 2 (missing street light poles arms and adding lights back to that pole) phase 3 LightTech to finish installing the last of the lights. The street lights total went from 250 to 135. Rebate was \$10,000.

Have Carolyn (Town Planner) send out a copy of the new master plan energy section (from the Planning committee

meeting on 7-9-2019) to the committee to review and comment.

Ann will call Granite Solar and Revision to set up appointments with David to tour the buildings and have them present their findings to the Energy Committee.
