

Dear NRRA Member,

Over the past several months, NRRA has seen an increase in dangerous unacceptable materials being inadvertently included in scrap metal loads to Radius (Formerly Schnitzer).

Examples include propane tanks, rechargeable batteries, and items with gasoline in them. Such materials pose a very serious safety hazard to their staff and machinery.

**Effective Immediately** the following fines will be enforced if items are found:

**Propane tanks, items still containing gas/fuel, batteries, & live ammunition rounds:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense: **\$275** (per unit)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: **\$525** (per unit) + **1 week suspension**
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense: **\$525** (per unit) + **indefinite suspension**

**CNG (compressed natural gas), Oxygen & Acetylene tanks:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense: **\$525** (per unit)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: **\$1,025** (per unit) + **1 week suspension**
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense: **\$1,025** (per unit) + **indefinite suspension**
