Dear NRRA Member,

Over the past several months, NRRA has seen an increase in dangerous unacceptable materials being inadvertently included in scrap metal loads to Radius (Formerly Schnitzer). Examples include propane tanks, rechargeable batteries, and items with gasoline in them. Such materials pose a very serious safety hazard to their staff and machinery.

Effective Immediately the following fines will be enforced if items are found:

Propane tanks, items still containing gas/fuel, batteries, & live ammunition rounds:

• 1st offense: \$275 (per unit)

• 2nd offense: \$525 (per unit) + 1 week suspension

• 3rd offense: \$525 (per unit) + indefinite suspension

CNG (compressed natural gas), Oxygen & Acetylene tanks:

• 1st offense: \$525 (per unit)

• 2nd offense: **\$1,025** (per unit) + 1 week suspension

• 3rd offense: **\$1,025** (per unit) + indefinite suspension
