

OHRV Use of Class VI Town Roads

The Pembroke Select Board, upon recommendation of the Pembroke Conservation Commission has voted to provide a limited season for OHRV use of Class VI town roads (range roads). This provides OHRVs a summer and fall season for access and limits use of the roads during “mud season” when roads are particularly vulnerable to damage from vehicles. In winter these roads are a recreational resource maintained by our local snowmobile club (The Trail Dawgs) for snowmobilers and winter pedestrian sports. This season is in line with the same dates that other towns across NH allow OHRV use of town roads.

Pembroke Town Code Chapter 185:

OHRV USE PROHIBITED ON RANGE ROADS

**December 16-May 31
(Snowmobiles Excepted)**

Violators will be fined \$150 for the first offence and \$300 for each subsequent offence within a calendar year, and shall be liable for any costs to repair, remedy, or otherwise return the road to an acceptable and stable condition as determined by the Public Works Director and pursuant to 236:38 and 236:39.
