3 Pembroke men arrested for Drug Sales

04/25/2011 – Pembroke, NH Three Pembroke men were arrested on Friday night 04/22/2011 for drug sales. The arrests culminated a 1 year investigation into drug sales in Pembroke conducted by the Pembroke Police Department and the Attorney General's Drug Task Force.



Robert Koehler, 36 years old, of 8 Lindy Street, Pembroke was charged with one count of Sale of Controlled Drug (oxymorhone). The offense is a class B felony, punishable by 3 ½ to 7 years in the state prison. He was released on \$10,000 personal recognizance bail. He will be arraigned in the Concord District Court on May 10th.

John Learned, 31 years old, of 23 Mason Avenue.

Pembroke. He was charged with one count of Sales of a Controlled Drug (oxycodone). The offense is a class B felony, punishable by 3 1/2 to7 years in prison. He was held on \$10,000 cash or surety. He has a probable cause

hearing scheduled for May 9 in the Concord District Court.



Nicholas Benjamin, 19 years old, of 79 Glass Street, Pembroke was charged with (3) counts of Sales of a Controlled/Narcotic Drug (marijuana) and (1) count of Attempted Sales of Controlled/Narcotic Drug. All (4) offenses are class B felonies punishable by 3 1/2 to 7 years in prison on each charge. He was held over the weekend at the Merrimack County Jail in Boscawen on \$20,000 cash bail. He was arraigned today in the Concord District Court where his bail was set at \$20,000 cash. A

probable cause hearing will be held on May 4th in the Concord District Court.
