FATAL Motorcycle/Motor Vehicle Collision Pembroke St

On 7/4/11 around 930 am, the Pembroke Police Department responded to a reported Motor Vehicle Collision involving a minivan and motor cycle in the area of 530 Pembroke St. Pembroke Fire Department, Concord Fire Department and Tri-town Ambulance treated the injured and transported 2 people to Concord Hospital.

The driver of the Motor Cycle identified as STEVEN DAHOOD, 51, of Allenstown NH after being transported to Concord Hospital was then airlifted to Mass General Hospital where he was pronounced dead due to the injuries sustained in the collision.

The driver of the minivan MELISSA OGUNGBADERO, 26, of Brookline, MA, sustained minor injuries but was not treated, a family member of hers was transported to the Concord Hospital for injuries sustained in this collision.

A preliminary investigation shows the Minivan was traveling southbound on Pembroke Street while the Motorcycle was traveling northbound. Witnesses state the minivan crossed the double yellow line striking the Motorcycle.

At this time Alcohol and Speed do not appear to be factors in this collision. This investigation is on going.
