

## MONTHLY SEWER COMMISSION MEETING

1. Meeting Called to Order: 6:58 pm

2. Citizen's Comments: None

**3.** Scheduled Meetings: a. Sub-Division Pembroke St, Brenton Cole, KNA: Brenton Cole of Keach-Nordstrom Associates, came in to talk to the commission about a sub-division for 16 new single family homes. They are asking for sewer capacity for this project. All of the sewage would go to the easement that crosses through the property by the river. They are requesting 4,466 gpd in capacity. The Commissioners explained that they would be meeting with the Allenstown Sewer Commission to talk about getting more capacity for the town. Also, once the project is approved by the commission Underwood Engineering would need to make comments on the project and this cost is paid by the developer. The beginning escrow would be \$2,500.00 and any additional fees would need to be paid

Paulette explained that she had a contract for the engineering review for this project. Approval for capacity will need to wait until we receive the allotment from Allenstown to move and get State approval.

**b. Pace Academy:** Mr. Santana from Pace Academy came in to discuss this project for 716-718 Riverwood Dr. Mr. Santana explained that he would be the only tenant in the building therefore, the 450

gpd allotment for the building will be adequate for this proposal. There has been a toilet running and currently the water to the toilet has been shut off until the repairs can be made.

**Motion:** Andy made the motion to allow Pace Academy to move forward with the 450 gpd allotment.

A discussion took place about a meeting with Allenstown that will take place on Tuesday July 17, 2018. Paulette explained that she got a quote from Underwood Engineers to look at our connection fees. This

would be so that we could justify the amount being charged to new and/or increase usage to the system. The amount of the contract is \$4,500.00.

**Motion:** Andy made the motion to have Harold sign the contract for Underwood Engineers to justify our connection fee for \$4,500.00.
